Explanatory notes:

1. Academic Year

- The academic year comprises two semesters, each of two blocks
- A block consists of 8 teaching-intensive weeks
- Each semester ends with a lecture-free period of 4 weeks

Semester I

- block 1: 31 August 2009 up to and including 25 October 2009
- block 2 : 26 October 2009 up to and including 20 December 2009

Semester II

- block 3 : 1 February 2010 up to and including 28 March 2010
- block 4 : 29 March 2010 up to and including 30 May 2010

2. Examinations

- Examinations take place in the lecture-free period, in August and interim in the last week of a teaching block
- In the EL CID week (16 to 20 August 2009) there are no examinations*

*No examinations applies only to subjects which are not part of the first study year (post-propedeuse subjects); re-sits for first-year subjects (propedeuse subjects) may take place during the EL-CID week

3. Public holidays/compulsory vacation days

- Relief of Leiden: 3 Oktober 2009
 - Cleveringareading: 26 November 2009, from 16.00 hrs no lectures
 - Christmas and New Year: 25 December 2009 up to and including 1 January 2010
 - Dies: 8 February 2010, from 13.00 hrs no lectures
 - Good Friday: 2 April 2010
 - Easter: 4 en 5 April 2010
 - Queen's Birthday: 30 April 2010
 - Liberation Day: 5 May 2010
 - Ascension Day: 13 and 14 May 2010
 - Whitsun: 23 and 24 May 2010
